(Greece v. Turkey)

The Court Extends Time-Limits for Written Proceedings

The following information is communicated to the Press by the Registry of the International Court of Justice:

On 18 April 1977 the International Court of Justice, responding to a request by Greece, made an Order by which, having regard to negotiations referred to by both Greece and Turkey, it extended the time-limits for the filing of written pleadings on the subject of the Court's jurisdiction to entertain the dispute.

Originally fixed at 18 April and 24 October 1977, respectively, the time-limits for a Memorial by Greece and a Counter-Memorial by Turkey have now been set at 18 July 1977 and 24 April 1978.
