The following information from the Registry of the International Court of Justice has been communicated to the Press.

The International Court of Justice held two public sittings to-day, April 14th, 1951, in the case concerning the Reservations to the Convention on Genocide.

Mr. G.G. Fitzmaurice, on behalf of the United Kingdom Government concluded the statement which Sir Hartley Shawcross began yesterday, and then Professor Rousseau made a statement on behalf of the French Government.

These sittings will be the last ones in the oral proceedings in the present advisory case.
