

The following information from the Registry of the International Court of Justice has been communicated to the Press:

In the Anglo-Iranian Oil Company case between the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and the Empire of Iran, the case for the Government of Iran, whose Agent before the Court is M. Hossein Navab, Iranian Minister at The Hague, will be presented by Dr. Mossadeq, Prime Minister of Iran, assisted by M. Nasrollah Entezam, Ambassador, former Minister.
