Legal Consequences for States of the Continued Presence
of South Africa in Namibia (South West Africa) notwithstanding
Security Council Resolution 276 (1970)

The following information is communicated to the Press by the
Registry of the International Court of Justice:

The Court will hold a closed meeting on Wednesday, 27 January 1971
at 10 a.m. to hear the representatives of South Africa on the question
of the entitlement of South Africa to choose a judge ad hoc
(Article 31 of the Statute).

admitted to this meeting (Article 46 of the Statute).
