The following information from the Registry of the International Court of Justice has been communicated to the Press :

By an Order dated May 5th, 1950, the President of the International Court of Justice appointed June 5th, 1950, as the time-limit for the deposit of written statements by Governments in the second phase of the advisory case concerning the interpretation of the Peace Treaties with Bulgaria, Hungary and Romania (Questions III and IV of the Resolution of the General Assembly of the United Nations of October 22nd, 1949).

The Governments of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and of the United States of America have availed themselves of this right and have deposited their statements within the time-limit fixed.
