The following information from the Registry of the International Court of Justice has been communicated to the Press:

The public hearings in the second phase of the advisory case concerning certain procedural questions relating to the interpretation of Peace Treaties with Bulgaria, Hungary and Romania will commence on Tuesday, June 27, at 11 a.m.

The Secretary-General of the United Nations as well as the following Governments have announced that an oral statement will be presented on their behalf.
