Continental Shelf (Tunisia/Libyan Arab Jamahiriya):
Filing of Memorials and Fixing of Time-limits for Counter-Memorials

The following information is made available to the Press by the Registry of the International Court of Justice:

On 30 May 1980, within the time-limit fixed by an Order of 20 February 1979, the Agents of the two Parties in the case concerning the delimitation of the continental shelf between Tunisia and the Libyan Arab Jamahiriya filed their respective Memorials; and these were then communicated to the other Party at a meeting with the President the same day.

On 3 June 1980 the President of the Court, having regard to the periods specified by the Parties in the Special Agreement through which they referred the case to the Court, made a further Order laying down the following time-limits for their respective Counter-Memorials:

- Tunisia: 1 December 1980;
- the Libyan Arab Jamahiriya: 2 February 1981.

The subsequent procedure has been reserved for further decision.
